What to Expect – As a Refugee Guest



Eligible Job Seekers / Refugee Guests (1/2)

Who is eligible to attend the event?

- Refugee status (right to work)
- Humanitarian protection status (right to work)

NB – Asylum seekers (who have the right to live in the UK but most likely not have the right to work in the UK yet due to pending decision from Home Office) will be assisted with information packs advising on path to right to work, alternative visa options, key contacts, etc.

What are valid forms of identification (ID)?

Refugee guests will be asked to present a valid form of ID at the entrance to enter the event, examples below include but are not exclusive to:

- Application Registration Card (assigned from Home Office), Passport, National ID, Drivers license, Proof of citizenship from country of origin, Home for Ukraine scheme digital ID

Support/help and benefits from attending the event?

- Refugees will gain support and advice to navigate the barriers related to employment, benefits, education, housing and health from the respective exhibitors
- Support with language translation on the day
- Opportunity to meet the contacts needed for multiple services in one session and build a relationship for future needs
- Greater understanding of the path to resettlement to better inform the wider refugee community
